Responsibilities:

- Dependent on the needs of our senior adults, and based on your preferences. Opportunities include:

 - Dusting

 - Sweeping/Mopping
 - Light Housework
 - Friendly Visitation
 - Window Washing
 - Organizing
 - Assistance w/ Garbage & Recycling
 - Yard/Garden Work
 - Mowing/Raking
 - Snow Removal
 - Small Repairs/Light Carpentry

Commitment:

- Flexible based on your own schedule.

Requirements:

- Must have own vehicle, valid driver's license and own auto insurance.
- Depending on interests, able to walk through differing types of terrain – possibly snow and ice in the Winter, as well as steps depending on the senior adult's residence.
- Possess great communication and listening skills, and able to be friendly and cordial with your assigned senior adult(s).
- Show empathy and understanding when working with senior adults, and able to keep confidentiality.
- Must pass a criminal background and personal references check.

- If you are over age 55, also an opportunity to affiliate with the Retired Senior Volunteer Program of Dane County (RSVP).
