Responsibilities:

- Serving lunch for the older adults attending and assisting with set-up of the dining space and food.
- Assisting with cleaning up the dining site, as well as cleaning the kitchen area based on our training procedures.
- Eat with and socialize with our older adults while working at the dining site.

Commitment:

- 9:30 am – 12:30 PM, Monday–Wednesday, and Friday. Volunteers are able to select shifts that fit their schedule.
- Minimum 1-year commitment.

Requirements:

- Possess great communication and listening skills, as well as willing to make visitors feel welcome within the dining site.
- Show empathy and understanding when working with older adults, and able to keep confidentiality.
- Able to follow food preparation and cleaning procedures.
- Must pass a criminal background and personal references check.

Benefits:

- One day before your volunteer shift, you are allowed to order a free meal.
- Recognition at our Annual Volunteer Recognition Celebration.
- If you are over age 55, also an opportunity to affiliate with the Retired Senior Volunteer Program of Dane County (RSVP).
