Programs – Foot Clinic Volunteer

We all spend a lot of time on our feet, so keeping them healthy is important. However, as you age it unfortunately becomes harder to care for your feet. Join NESCO and SSM Health @ Home to make sure our older adults get the help they need, and keep their feet healthy!

Responsibilities:

- Prepare the foot clinic site for clients by putting up signage, greeting participants, setting chairs, and receiving and recording payments for their appointment.
- Prepare containers with warm water in preparation for each client's feet soaking.
- Tear down and clean up the foot clinic site.

Commitment:

- Dependent on volunteer's location preference:

 - Madison Public Health Department (Eastside Shopping Center)
 - 9:30 AM – 11:15 AM, first Tuesday each month.
 - St. Paul Lutheran Church, 2136 N. Sherman Ave.
 - 1 PM – 2:45 PM, second Tuesday each month.
 - Warner Park Community Recreation Center, 1625 Northport Dr.
 - 10 AM – 11:45 AM, second Friday each month.
- Minimum 1-year commitment.

Requirements:

- Ability to carry containers filled with water.
- Comfortable with money management.
- Must have own method of transportation.
- Show empathy and understanding when working with older adults, and ability to maintain confidentiality.
- Must pass a criminal background and personal references check.
